

**NOTICE OF VACANCY IN THE OFFICE OF  
DISTRICT ASSOCIATE COURT JUDGE**

Notice is hereby given that the Judicial Magistrate Appointing Commissions from Hamilton, Hardin, and Wright Counties will meet on January 28, 2022 at 9:30 AM, in the lower level meeting room at the Hamilton County Courthouse, 2300 Superior Street, Webster City, Iowa. These combined magistrate appointing commissions will nominate three (3) persons for the position of district associate court judge. The appointment is to fill the vacancy created by the appointment of Judge Derek Johnson to the 2B District Court bench. The new district associate court judge will cover district associate court cases in Hamilton, Hardin, and Wright counties; magistrate level cases in Hamilton and Hardin counties; juvenile work in Hamilton and Wright county, and other case work as deemed appropriate by the Chief Judge. On February 11, 2022 one of the three (3) persons nominated by the commission will be selected by the district court judges of Judicial Election Sub-District 2B to fill the position of district associate court judge for a term to commence on or about March 14, 2022.

Copies of applications shall be sent directly to each commission member by the applicant and received by the commission member by the same deadline.
