The Crawford County Magistrate Nominating Commission met on Friday, July 1, 2022 to appoint one part time Magistrate to fill the vacancy created by the retirement of Magistrate William Ranniger on July 7, 2022.

The commission appointed: Brad L. Bonner.

Magistrates serve part time and have jurisdiction over simple misdemeanors, including scheduled violations, county and municipal infractions, and small claims cases. Magistrates have authority to issue search warrants, conduct preliminary hearings, and hear certain involuntary hospitalization and juvenile matters. Magistrates may be assigned by the Chief Judge to work in counties within the District other than the county appointed.
