NOTICE OF VACANCY OF 3A District Associate Judge

TO: All Applicants for 3A District Associate Judge Vacancy
DATE: October 7, 2024

On September 26, 2024, the State Commissioner of Elections provided the required statutory notice that the vacancy exists in the office of District Associate Judge for the 3A Judicial District due to appointment of Judge Andrew Smith to the District Court bench. The person appointed to fill this vacancy will be expected to carry out any assignment made by the Chief Judge of the Third Judicial District that is within the jurisdiction of a district associate judge, as defined in Iowa Code Sections 602.6305 and 602.6306.

To be considered by the Commission, the original completed application must be emailed to the District Court Administrator's office at d3judicialnominating.commis@iowacourts.gov no later than Thursday, October 24, 2024 by 4:30 PM and a copy emailed to each Commissioner by that same date and time at the email addresses listed.

No application will be accepted after 4:30 PM on October 24, 2024, regardless of the reason. Any application, together with supporting documents and letters of support, must be emailed to the commissioners at the email addresses listed.

Applicants for the position must be members of the Iowa Bar and residents of 3A Judicial District or of a county contiguous to the 3A Judicial District. Applicants must also be of an age that will allow them to complete the initial term of office before reaching age seventy-two. The present salary for the position is \$147,520.00.

The 3A Judicial Nominating Commission has set Thursday, November 7, 2024, as the date for a meeting at which applicants for the position will be interviewed by the Commission. Following the interview, the Commission will, in all probability, proceed by ballot to nominate two applicants for the position. The interviews and balloting will take place at the **Cherokee County Courthouse, 520 W. Main St., Cherokee, IA.**

The names of the two nominees will then be sent to the Governor, who has 30 days within which to appoint one of the two nominees to fill the vacancy.

The person appointed to the position will serve an initial term of one year after appointment and until January 1 following the next judicial election after expiration of such year, and the regular term of office of a District Associate Judge retained at a judicial election shall be six years from the expiration of the initial or previous regular term. Retirement of District Associate Judges in Iowa is mandatory at age seventy-two.

There is no requirement for applicants to personally interview the Commissioners, nor is there a requirement for applicants to obtain letters of support. It is up to each individual Commissioner to determine whether or not he or she will schedule personal interviews with applicants; however, the individual policy of a Commissioner in this regard is to be applied consistently to all applicants who request an interview in a timely manner.
