

Notice Regarding Appointment of Magistrate

The magistrate appointing commission for Hardin County will meet at the Courthouse on June 7, 2019 at 9:00 a.m. for the purpose of appointing one magistrate for a term beginning July 1, 2019, and ending July 31, 2021. This position will include full magistrate duties and will no longer be shared with a district associate judge as the weighted workload has fallen below two magistrates.

Pursuant to Iowa Code section 602.6404, the qualifications include:

1. A magistrate shall be a resident of the county of appointment or of a county contiguous to the county of appointment during the magistrate's term of office.
2. A person is not qualified for appointment as a magistrate if at the time of appointment the person has reached age seventy-two.
3. A magistrate shall be an attorney licensed to practice law in this state.

Application forms may be obtained from the Hardin County Clerk of Court. Completed application forms must be received by the Hardin Clerk of Court, 1215 Edington Ave, Eldora, IA 50627, no later than May 29, 2019 at 3:30 p.m.
