

NOTICE OF JUDICIAL VACANCY

The Judicial Nominating Commission for judicial election district 5-C received notification on July 19, 2022 that there is a District Associate Judge vacancy in Polk County, Iowa, as the result of a newly created position pursuant to Iowa Code section 602.6301. This vacancy will be filled in accordance with the provisions of Iowa Code section 602.6304. The person appointed to this position will be expected to carry out any assignment made by the Chief Judge of the Fifth Judicial district that is within the jurisdiction of a district associate judge, as defined in Iowa Code section 602.6306. **HOWEVER, THE APPOINTEE WILL LIKELY BE ASSIGNED PRIMARILY TO A JUVENILE COURT DOCKET.**

Anyone who wishes to be considered for appointment to fill this vacancy must complete a written application as described below. Applicants for this position must have the following minimum qualifications: (1) be an attorney admitted to practice law in Iowa; (2) be a resident of judicial election district 5-C at the time of appointment and must remain a resident of judicial election district 5-C throughout the term of office, as defined in Iowa Code section 602.6305(3); and (3) be able, measured by the person's age at the time of appointment, to complete the initial term of office, as defined in Iowa Code section 46.16(2), prior to reaching age seventy-two (72).



PLEASE NOTE THAT THE APPLICATION MUST BE RECEIVED BY THE CHAIR AND THE ADDITIONAL COMMISSIONERS BY THAT DEADLINE – MERE MAILING BY THE DEADLINE IS INSUFFICIENT.
