NOTICE IN THE VACANCY OF THE OFFICE OF DISTRICT ASSOCIATE JUDGE**

The Woodbury, Ida, Crawford, Buena Vista and Cherokee County Judicial Magistrate Appointing Commissions will meet in the District Court courtroom at the Ida County Courthouse in Ida Grove, Ida County, Iowa, on September 24, 2021, at 9:00 a.m. for the purpose of interviewing and nominating three nominees to fill one position of District Associate Judge covering the above counties in District 3A and 3B for a term commencing after November 11, 2021. This vacancy is created by the impending retirement of Judge Mary Timko. The meeting will also be conducted by videoconference through the following website:

The three nominees will then be interviewed by the District Judges for District 3A and 3B at a later time and date, and the District Judges will appoint one of the nominees to fill the vacant position.

All applicants must be an attorney licensed to practice law in the state of Iowa. Applicants must be a resident of the 3A or 3B judicial subdistrict at the time of appointment and must be able to complete the initial term of office prior to reaching age 72. Additional information, duties, qualifications and summary of benefits can be obtained with the application.
